



You must use your credentials. It is important to use Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome as other browsers may cause issues.




## PHASE 2 – COURSE SELECTION

## COURSE: "SPANISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (6ECTS)" "ESPAÑOL LENGUA EXTRANJERA (6 CRÉDITOS)"

In order to take this course, it is mandatory to take an on-line test to determine your level of Spanish Language proficiency prior to enrollment. We have already sent you the instructions of how to do the Spanish test online and it will be closed on DECEMBER 19<sup>th</sup>. In the previous days before the semester starts, you will receive the result of the Spanish test with the level assigned and group to you by email. Once Phase 2 (course selection) opens, this course will be automatically added to your application (within your proposal of courses for enrollment) without the need for you to select it. You should check that the Spanish course with the level assigned to you is added to your application before your final enrollment.

#### With this course you have three options:

- Option 1 leave the course in your application and you will receive credits for this course on your transcript.
- Option 2 you take the course but do not receive credit, it will not appear on your transcript. In this case you have to delete it from your application so it will not appear on your transcript.
- Option 3 you do not take the course. You will need to delete the course from your application.



### TYPE OF COURSES

- FULL YEAR STUDENTS You can choose annual or semester-long classes. The annual courses are for the whole academic year. Students therefore cannot drop the course in their second semester or add an annual course in the second semester
- SEMESTER STUDENTS If you're only coming for a semester, you can only select semester courses.

• The first semester classes begin on September 2<sup>nd</sup> and finish on December 20<sup>th</sup>. The second semester classes begin on

January 13th and finish on May 21st.

1st & 2nd Sem – the same course is taught in both semesters

SEM elective – may be available in the first sem. or in the second sem.


Annual - course that has a duration of a complete academic year.

#### TWO TYPES OF COURSES:


#### TYPE 1 - COURSES THAT BELONG TO THE DIPLOMA HUGO:

The diploma HUGO courses (6 ECTS each) have a special regime. These courses will start on January 13<sup>th</sup> and end on April 30<sup>th</sup>. (including classes and exams). The rest of the courses that do not belong to the diploma and are degree courses with Spanish students will start on January 13<sup>th</sup> and end on May 21<sup>st</sup>. (including classes and exams).

If you take 4 HUGO (24 ECTS) diploma courses, you can obtain this diploma. For this, it is important that, if you take at least these 24 ECTS, you indicate in your "Select/Change Courses" section the option YES to "Solicitar la inscripción" in the DIPLOMA". The "Spanish as a foreign language" course is also part of this diploma and is worth 6 ECTS.






#### TWO TYPES OF COURSES:

#### TYPE 2 – GENERAL UNDERGRADUATE COURSES:

It is mandatory if a student take courses that don't belong to the diploma HUGO that they must follow the rules/norms like the rest of the Comillas students.

In the case of these courses, the exam period will be from April 28<sup>th</sup> to May 21<sup>th</sup> and we can't move the exams.





#### NUMBER OF ECTS YOU CAN TAKE:

The application will allow you to select a maximum of 36 ECTS or 6 courses (remember that if you have taken the Spanish test we will add "Spanish as a foreign language" at your selection of courses too) and you can add 4 courses on the waiting list.

If your university has instructed you to do 30 ECTS, I recommend you to select 36 ECTS, as you will have from January 9<sup>th</sup> to January 24<sup>th</sup> to modify your selection. During the first few days of class there are always schedule changes that can affect your course selection.

Incoming students usually take between 24 ECTS and 30 ECTS with a maximum of 36 ECTS in some cases (we do not recommend overloading).

We do not have a mínimum requirement. You are free to choose the number of ECTS. The only limit is set by your home university, which will determine the number of ECTS you need to complete here.

A semester long class of 6 ECTS = 4 contact hours per week

A semester long class of 3ECTS = 2 contact hours per week

A semester long class of 4,5 ECTS = 3 contact hours per week




### PRE-REGISTRATION

This preliminary course selection may be modified at any time during the add/dropp period, (two weeks after classes start)

Deadline period for add and drop courses January 24<sup>th</sup>.


- Courses matriculated- Once the add and drop period finish you will be officially matriculated.
- Proposal of courses Courses remain here until they are approved by the Comillas coordinator.
- Waiting list Once the add and drop period ends no courses should be listed in this section. You must delete them if the Comillas coordinator has not approved them.






## HOW TO FIND A COURSE AND ADD IT TO YOUR PROPOSAL OF COURSES

 You only need to enter one word to find the course, you don't need to enter the full name (e.g.: comunica)







## HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE INFORMATION THAT APPEARS NEXT TO A COURSE



### WHAT HAPPENS IF THE COURSE IS FULL

- If a course is full, it will appear in red and crossed out. If you really need to take the course, you can add it to the waiting list by clicking on the Notepad Icon.
- You can only have up to 4 courses in your waiting list.
- You should remove a course in the Waiting List box if you are no longer interested in taking the class as soon as possible.





#### WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU HAVE A COURSE IN YOUR WAITING LIST

- We will contact you by email from December 20<sup>th</sup> to January 24<sup>th</sup> to let you know which course on your waiting list has space available. This course can be included in your list of proposed courses as long as you have no more than 36 credits.
- In case you have more than 36 credits in your list of proposed courses we will send you an
  email to let us know which course you want to remove from the proposed ones and we will
  give you 24 hours to respond.
- If you do not respond, we will move on to the next student on the waiting list. We have limited number of spots for each of the courses.
- It is important that the student replies to the messages so that we can be agile in providing you with a service.




#### PHASE 3


#### "Modify health insurance data"
