Health care

Non-EU nationals

- Non-EU students need a private health insurance plan prior to arrival.
- Lists of doctors are available from your health insurance provider and embassies.
- When making an appointment, call your insurance company first to let them know you're sick and seeking medical attention They'll either provide you with a preferred doctor or you can tell them you've chosen another one.



EU nationals

- EU students are covered by the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) issued by the country of origin <u>health insurance provider</u>. A free card that gives you access to medically necessary, state-provided healthcare, free of charge.
- Dental treatment is generally not available under the state system.

- Private Insurance: If your insurance doesn't cover the costs, tests could range from about 30 to 35€ Antigen tests and 80 to 125€ PCR tests.
