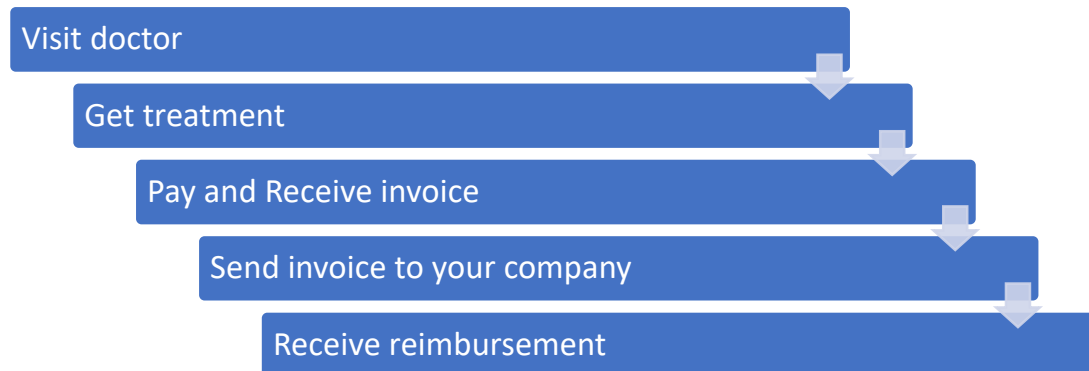

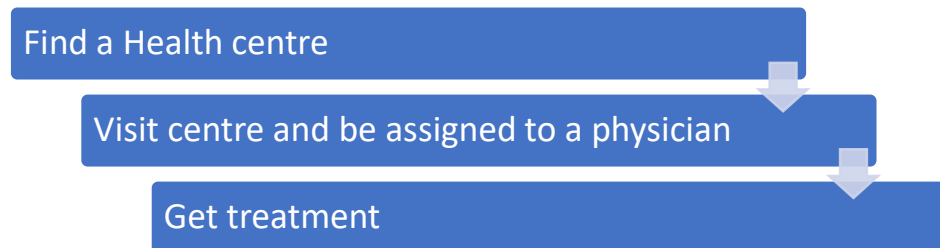
Non-EU nationals

- Non-EU students need a private health insurance plan prior to arrival.
- Lists of doctors are available from your health insurance provider and embassies.
- When making an appointment, call your insurance company first to let them know you're sick and seeking medical attention. They'll either provide you with a preferred doctor or you can tell them you've chosen another one.



EU nationals

- EU students are covered by the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) issued by the country of origin [health insurance provider](#). A free card that gives you access to medically necessary, state-provided healthcare, free of charge.
- Dental treatment is generally not available under the state system.

- A referral from a doctor is needed for any hospital treatment, except in an emergency.

- ✓ Call our 24/7 Emergency Phone number (PGR/SGR): +34654349436
- ✓ Contact your Public Health Centre or Private Clinic for: PCR/antigen test, treatment if needed and follow-up.

- Public/State-provided healthcare: free if you have symptoms or have had contact with someone infected.
- Private Insurance: If your insurance doesn't cover the costs, tests could range from about 30 to 35€ Antigen tests and 80 to 125€ PCR tests.
