INFORMATION ABOUT THE COURSE

Objectives

The methodological framework of the *Communicative Task-based Approach and Collaborative Action-based Learning*, is designed to:

- Provide students with the necessary strategies and skills to function both in academic settings and in the daily situations.
- Enable the student to express him/herself both orally and in writing about the knowledge he acquires.
- Enable the student to understand oral and written statements and texts on both every day and specific topics and know how to answer questions when asked.

Oral production and interaction	 Handle oneself in most situations likely to arise while traveling in an area where the language is used Describe experiences and events, dreams, wishes and hopes and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions or explain plans.
