



# Types of Housing!

### **Shared Apartments**

Probably the most affordable option with an average rent of 500€ per month (without expenses)

- More social atmosphere
- Share the "house work"
- Make friends easily
- Noisier

### **Student Residency**

Living in a residency is more costly but puts you in contact with many like-minded peers

- Meal plans
- Social atmosphere
- Support system
- More costly
- Strict rules

### **Studio Apartments**

More expensive than sharing a flat and less availability throughout the city

- Quiet atmosphere
- Independence
- More costly
- Less social connection

## **Homestay**

Living with a Spanish family will foster cultural exchange but less personal freedom during your time in Madrid

- Secure residence
- Cultural integration
- Strict rules
- Less social connection

# Agencies, Residencies & Popular Online Platforms

### **Free Search Platforms**

Apartments are uploaded to these platforms by everyone, private owners, people searching for a roommate and agencies. In case of private landlords, negotiations are handled directly between the owner and the one searching.

#### What to Expect

- Completely free
- Landlords often don't rent to foreigners short term
- Language barriers
- Offers mostly for complete apartments & studios
- Higher potential for scam

# Housing Agencies & Residencies

Housing agencies are private companies that manage many flats around Madrid. They typically rent individual rooms in shared flats, but some will also have studio apartments or rent entire flats.

#### **What to Expect**

- More expensive
- Trustworthy platforms
- Contract support
- Flat manager for support throughout
- Many roommates
- International atmosphere

### **Paid Search Platforms**

These search platforms don't own their own flats. They advertise locations that they inspect and trust. These apartments might be owned by private citizens or agencies.

#### What to Expect

- Will charge a booking fee
- Potential double fee (platform fees & agency fees)
- Great selection
- Safe platform to avoid scam
- Not possible to visit the flat before
- International atmosphere

### **Free Search Platforms**

Rooms and apartments are uploaded to these platforms by everyone, private owners, people searching for a roommate and agencies.

In case of private landlords, negotiations are handled directly between the owner and the one searching.

#### What to Expect

- Completely free no agency fee paid to the platform itself
- Private landlords often don't rent to foreigners short term
- Private landlords might not offer signing a contract very important for non EU citizens, because without a contract you can't apply for Empadronamiento
- Language barriers most private landlords don't speak English
- Offers mostly for complete apartments & studios with long term contract (more Higher potential for scam

















## Rental Agencies Offering Rooms, Studios and Appartments for Students

Housing agencies are private companies that manage many flats around Madrid. They typically rent individual rooms in shared flats, but some will also have studio apartments or rent entire flats. This is the recommended option when you book before your arrival so that everything is more formal and secure.

#### What to Expect

- More expensive than free platforms or if you rent privately
- Reliable companies when booking from home and without seeing the apartment or room in person.
- Contract support
- Flat manager for support throughout
- Possibility to visit before booking
- Many roommates
- International atmosphere

























## Student Residences Offering Single and Double Rooms

There are many student residence buildings throughout the city that offer a sophisticated style with a modern design to ensure a unique experience abroad. There is the possibility of renting either a single or double room.



- More expensive than renting an apartment in a shared room

# Understand your Contract, Avoiding Potential Problems & Scams

## What to look for in the contract?

- Am I renting through an agency or private landlord?
- Is there an agency commission?
- How much is the rent? Is it monthly payments or all at once upfront?
- What is a deposit and how much is it? When and how do I get it back?
- Is water, electricity, gas, community fee and internet included?
- Is there a code of conduct?
- Are there visiting hours? A fee for friends to stay?
- Is it furnished and are linens and blankets provided?
- Is there a check-in checklist for potential damages?
- If I leave before the end of contract, what are the penalties?

### **Multi Transportation Card**

**Price:** 2,5€

**Use:** This is a "use as you go" type of card. You can either top it up once you need to take a ride or top up 10 rides in advance

Where to use it: Madrid Metro, urban & night buses

How to get it: You can get it at any machine at the entry of any metro station

**Documents:** No documents required

If you lose it: You have to get a new one for 2,5€



### **Personal Transportation Card**

Price: 4€

**Use:** This card gives you access to your monthly transportation pass - it needs to be topped up once a month

Where to use it: You can use it on all of Madrid's public transportation. You can also use it as a Multi card

**How to get it:** You can order it online (takes up to 15 work days) or by appointment

**Documents:** Passport / ID (EU only) and passport size photo

If you lose it: You can request a replacement for 6€



## **Abono Joven vs. Abono Normal**

Every 30 days you will need to top up your personal transportation card, which will grant you **unlimited access** to **all public transportation** in the city.

# How to Order Your Personal Transportation Card



## The process is simple:

- Visit the official <u>Consorcio de Transportes de Madrid</u> website
- Select the type of card you'd like ("Tarjeta Transporte Público")
- Select your age range
- Fill out the online form (make sure to indicate the Citylife office address & phone number so we can save it for you)
- Get all instructions how to fill out there form <u>here</u>.
- Submit the required documentation
- Pay the 4€ fee
- Pick it up upon your arrival

If you are moving to Spain for a period of **more than 3 months**, you will need to purchase private health insurance that covers the duration of your stay in Spain.

This is a mandatory requirement for any **visa application** as proof of sufficient coverage must be submitted with the application.





### What Documents do you Need to Live, Work and Study Legally in Spain!



\*Citizens of the EU and equivalent refers to: citizens of the EU (Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Republic of Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain and Sweden), the European Economic Area (EEA): Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway, and Switzerland.



### Citizen of the European Union or equivalent \*

#### NIE Spain – What is a NIE Card (EU Citizens)?

The NIE card is officially known as the "Certificado de Registro de Ciudadano de la UE". This is the document that citizens of the European Union (or equivalent) should apply for when moving to Madrid to work or study for **longer than 3 months**.

#### What is the Empadronamiento & Who Needs to Apply for it?

The Empadronamiento is a general census record of habitants in the city, which allows the municipal government to allocate the right amount of funds and community services to a particular region or neighbourhood of the city (healthcare centres, police, maintenance, etc.) Once a person is registered ("empadronado/a"), they will officially become a member of the community and their presence in Spain will be verified.

#### What is the Social Security Number & Who Needs to Apply for it?

The Social Security number is officially known as the "Número de Afiliación de la Seguridad Social". It's mandatory to obtain in order to be able to work legally in Spain. EU citizens can apply for it with their passport or NIE (if already available).





### **Non-EU Citizens**



#### Visa / NIE / TIE - What do Non-EU citizens need to apply for?

**Visa** – Usually applied at the embassy / consulate at your home country. If you'll stay to less than 6 months it will be granted for the entire period of your stay. If you'll stay for more than 6 months, you'll be granted a 90 days visa to enter the country and apply for your TIE. It's possible to apply from Spain too, but takes up to 3-4 months to be approved.

Once your visa is granted, you'll get a **NIE** number assigned to your Visa. It's either printed on the visa or you'll need to requested once in Spain.

**TIE** - This is the document that all Non-Europeans who are staying in Spain for more than 6 months will need to apply for, as the visa you'll have granted will be for only 90 days. You need to apply for your TIE within the first 30 days entering Spain.

#### What is the Empadronamiento & Who Needs to Apply for it?

The Empadronamiento is a general census record of habitants in the city and once a person is registered ("empadronado/a"), they will officially become a member of the community and their presence in Spain will be verified. In order to obtain your TIE, you will first need to apply for the Padron. To do so, your rental contract needs to be valid at least for 6 months.

What is the Social Security Number & Who Needs to Apply for it?

The Social Security number is officially known as the "Número de Afiliación de la Seguridad Social". It's mandatory to obtain in order to be able to work legally in Spain. Non-EU citizens can only apply if in possession of valid work permit.




