ICADE. FACT SHEET

- Comillas Pontifical University is a private Catholic university administered by the Society of Jesus, the Jesuits.
- Founded in 1890. Originally located in Comillas, Cantabria, the university moved to Madrid in 1969.
- ➤ Known as ICAI-ICADE. ICAI = School of Engineering. ICADE = Faculty of Law and Faculty of Business.
- ➤ ICADE building is divided into two wings: Faculty of Law (east wing Este in Spanish) and Faculty of Business (west wing Oeste in Spanish).
- One of the top private universities in Madrid, Spain.
- Approximately 15,555 students, of which 3,000 are foreign students.

- You can mix courses from different undergraduate degree programs (mainly 4th and 5th year courses).
- A Bachelor's Degree in Spain usually requires a minimum of four years full-time study (five years for Double Degrees).





TEACHING, CLASSES AND EXAMS AT COMILLAS

- Teaching system will remain 100% face-to-face (both classes and exams).
- Students will be informed of the contents, teaching method, assessment requirements, the weighting of each component and the marking criteria for each course at the start of the academic year. Read the syllabi carefully.
- **Teaching methodologies**: Lectures, accompanied by practical work (in teams or individually, oral presentations).
- **Grading scale**: A scale from 0 (lowest) to 10 (highest), awarded per assignment and/or exam. "Suspenso" (FAIL) from 0 to 4.9. "Aprobado" (PASS) from 5.0 to 6.9. "Notable" (GOOD) from 7 to 8.9. "Sobresaliente" (EXCELLENT) from 9 to 10.
- Regular and punctual class attendance. In some courses, professors may have special attendance requirements; these should be made known to students during the first week of classes.
- Moodle = Learning Platform. Assignments, learning materials, announcements (cancellations, class changes). Identify the student representative/delegate or "delegado de clase" for each course. Ask him/her to add you to their WhatsApp group
- Absences: a student should not miss more than 20% of the scheduled classes per course. If
 you are unable to attend class due to illness or personal matters, you must proactively
 communicate with each professor or your academic advisor to receive consideration for an excused
 absence.
- All official student email correspondence will be sent only to a student's Comillas email address.

Spring / Second Semester / SEM 2:

- Classes: 13th January 25th April.
- Exams period* (first attempt):
 - Second semester: 28th April-21st May 2025.
- Extraordinary exam period (resit**): 9th June 27th June 2025.
- *Examination timetables will be available in late March. Do not plan your travel back before your last exam, no exception will be made.
- **Only if you fail an exam. Ask your home coordinator if you have to do the resit at Comillas or they offer you another option.

<u>Distance exams are not allowed.</u> Examination timetables will be released in late October. Do not plan your travel back before your last exam, no exception will be made.

TRANSCRIPTS OF RECORDS: at the end of each exam session, we will send the official Transcript of Records to your home coordinators by email. Dates: Autumn Semester: February. Spring semester: June. Resit exam: July.

- Courses Pre-registration: From 3rd December to Monday 16th December 2024:
 - ✓ Add your preferred list of courses.
 - ✓ Check your provisional course schedule on "<u>see schedule</u>". Avoid timetable clashes!
 - ✓ Waiting list: confirmation by 20th December 2024.

Phases II &

- Official Enrolment* / Add&Drop Period: 13th to 24th January 2025:
 - √ Change your course selection, if you need it. Avoid timetable clashes!
 - ✓ Complete the required data and upload a copy of your private health insurance or EHIC card.




- Official Enrolment. Online Application Submission: 13th to 24th January 2025:
 - ✓ Click on Phase IV: "Online submission of your application".
 - ✓ Enter the code received in your Comillas email account. Click on "sign application".
 - ✓ No changes will be allowed after submitting your phase IV by 24th January (except deleting courses with your University authorisation by 30th January)



General considerations:

- To be completed between 13th January and 24th January 2025.
- Course load: Maximum 36 ECTS per semester (including the Spanish language course). You can mix courses
 from different years (4th or 5th) and degrees. No minimum number of ECTS. Consult with your home coordinator at your
 University.
- ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY (maximum 20% absence).
- ECTS credits. A 6-credit course = 2 classes per week. A 3-credit course = 1 class per week. 2 hours each class.
- · Provisional access to all your approved courses on Moodle before enrolment.
- Comillas Law Faculty. Course Catalogue for Exchange Students. Click on the course titles to read the syllabus of each course (check Pre-requirements)
- Diploma in Legal Studies in Spain (optional, minimum 20 ECTS. Fee: 35,50€ + shipping fees). If you are interested in registering for this diploma, please select it in your Phase II during the enrolment period by 24th January (see screenshot below): "Solicito la inscripción en el Diploma en Legal Studies in Spain."

- Compulsory online level test (to be completed before 19th December). Level, timetable and classroom notified by email (to your Comillas email address).
- If you took the level test, this course will be automatically added to your online selection. If you do NOT want the course "Spanish" to appear on your transcript, delete it from your Phase II (add&drop period).
- Schedule: From 2:30 to 4:00pm twice a week. Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday.
- Classes will start during the week of the 13th January, depending on your level.



CHECKLIST UPON ARRIVAL

- □Compulsory Orientation Sessions: attend our welcome sessions in January;
- □Certificate of arrival: If your home institution requires a confirmation of arrival, please come to the Law Faculty (2nd floor, east wing) with your form to get it signed;
- □Official Enrolment (Phases I, II, III and IV): Add& drop period. You have to submit your whole application. From 13th to 24th January.
- □ Health Insurance: Exchange students must have comprehensive health and liability insurance before their arrival, and valid for the entire period of their stay in Spain. You must upload proof of your insurance upon arrival. EHIC card for EU students and private health insurance for non-EU.
- □Changes to the E+ Learning Agreement (LA): If you wish to make any changes to your LA, please contact the Mobility Coordinator at your home university. Then bring the signed document to the Faculty of Law to get our signature too. Our email: internacional.der@comillas.edu
- □ Search <u>accommodation in Madrid</u>.
- □Transportation: Order your monthly pass card "abono joven" (metro, buses, trains).
- □ <u>Healthcare in Madrid</u>. Locate your closest healthcare centre ("<u>centro de salud</u>") in Madrid. Dentist in Madrid (English speaking). Private insurance: HM hospital or Quirónsalud.
- □ Required legal procedures upon arrival (NIE, TIE).



CHECKLIST UPON ARRIVAL

EU students:

Stay longer than 3 months: you must register at the <u>Registro Central de Extranjeros (EU Registration</u> <u>Certificate</u>) within three months from the date of entry into Spain. CITYLIFE: Check the following <u>link</u>.

Non-EU students:

Non-UE students coming to Comillas with student visa:

• Stay less than 6 months: for 180-day stays/visa, you should not perform any procedure.

Non-UE students coming to Comillas without the necessary student visa:

- Authorization of Stay for Study Purposes (for stays over 3 months): students without the necessary visa, who are allowed to enter in Spain with his/her passport, must apply for the initial Authorization to Stay for Studies from Spain within the first 30-50 days from the arrival date. <u>Link</u> to the application and instructions (in Spanish)

*Non-EU students coming from Universities in EU countries. If you have a residence permit for studies in another EU country, you do not have to apply for a visa. 
