

DOCUMENTACIÓN PARA INTERCAMBIOS EN UNIVERSIDADES SOCIAS DE EE.UU.

Certificado de finanzas

Las Universidades americanas son responsables ante el gobierno de comprobar que los alumnos disponen de suficientes fondos para sostenerse económicamente durante la duración de su estancia (alojamiento, manutención, etc.).

No se emitirán documentos de inmigración necesarios para solicitar un visado si no se aportan las pruebas requeridas.

Los documentos aportados no se devolverán al alumno, por tanto, es necesario que quedarse con copia de los mismos para presentar en la embajada cuando se solicite el visado.

Documentos que se suelen solicitar:

Carta o formulario por parte del alumno si se financia con medios propios, o de la persona/institución que financia al alumno, indicando de qué gastos se hace cargo, duración del intercambio, cantidad que se garantiza. *A letter of sponsorship/affidavit of support which indicates that your sponsor is willing and able to support you financially for your academic fees and living expenses throughout the duration of your studies.*

Carta de banco en papel oficial que consigne la cantidad que se garantiza. Puede ser la cuenta bancaria del propio alumno, o de otro particular (padre, familiar), si le financian. *An official bank letter, bank statement or credit reference from a bank stating the availability of the minimum estimated expenses as indicated on the "Estimate of Expences".*

La documentación aportada normalmente debe ser (consultar las instrucciones enviadas):

- en inglés
- reciente
- original
- se debe indicar el periodo de intercambio
- la cantidad a consignar debe cubrir los gastos en los que el alumno incurrirá. Normalmente se indica la cantidad mínima que se debe garantizar en las instrucciones enviadas al alumno por la Universidad de destino. Cantidades aquí recogidas corresponden a años anteriores, por tanto, comprobar que la cantidad está actualizada para el curso académico 2022-2023.

- *If you are supporting yourself, please submit a current financial statement or [bank letter](#) from your bank indicating that your account holds the necessary funds.*
- *If you are being financially supported by an individual other than yourself, we need a current financial statement or [bank letter](#) from your sponsor's bank showing the availability of funds to cover your personal and academic expenses at BU, plus a [Sponsor Certification Form](#) which states that he/she will pay for your fees and living expenses for the duration of your studies at Boston University School of Law.*

Directions for Completing the Declaration of Finances (DCF) Form

1. Complete the Declaration of Finances form.
2. Include proof of funding for the total estimate of student expenses of \$12,300. Proof of funding can include:
 - **Personal funds (including parents):**
 - A bank statement no older than 2 months old OR
 - A bank letter signed and stamped by a bank official noting the amount of available funds in the account. The statement must be in ENGLISH on bank letterhead and must include the bank's contact information.
 - **Sponsor funds:** The sponsor's name must appear on the statement and their name should be listed under the guarantor on the DCF Form. If you have more than one sponsor, please include a letter(s) from additional sponsors on a separate page.
 - **Scholarship:** If you receive a scholarship or grant from your government or home university, you must include a copy of the official scholarship/grant letter with your DCF.
3. Make copies of this form and the required certification documents before submitting them to Boston College as you will need to show proof of funding to the U.S. consular officers when applying for a visa.

- MALTUS: test en la piel. Si da positivo te hacen una placa de pecho para ver si hay algún problema. Lo hacen en la S.S.
- IGRA: análisis de sangre. Hay un laboratorio en A.A. en frente de El Corte Inglés. Los resultados tardan. ASISA lo cubre.
