STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY & AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT

Therefore your admission application must include the Statement of Financial Responsibility as well as a bank statement or a letter from your sponsor's bank dated within six months of the start of the semester at Elon University showing the amount of funds available. If your sponsor is not your parent or yourself, please include a brief letter from your sponsor stating the relation and his/her intent to support all your expenses during your program of studies at Elon University.
