


# **Our Students**


- 35,479 students (student-faculty ratio 13:1) from all NC counties, all 50 states and 120+ countries

- 9,712 degrees awarded in 2017-18 academic year



## Visas

- IPBS Students will be coming to NC State on a J-1 Visa.
- Once admitted, NC State will issue DS-2019, which you take to US Embassy/Consulate for visa application
- Eligible for Academic Training, which allows you to work. One month of school = one month of Academic Training.
- You will have post degree academic training ~ 12-18 months
