ICADE-Tulane Dual Degree Student FAQ

What can ICADE students expect at Tulane?

Students will need to complete at least 62 credits at Tulane, about 15 to 16 credits a semester, or 5 to 6 courses. Some students will need more based on credit transferred in and chosen majors, but at least 62 credits are needed to get a Tulane diploma. Students should be mindful that not all courses available to them will count toward the degree, so they should have their schedule reviewed every semester.

What courses are ICADE students expected to take?

- o ENGL1010(English) or ENGL1011(English for non-native speakers)
- o Laboratory Science
- o Psychology (PSYC1000)
- o A 3000 level or higher course with a public service element
- o CDMA1201(career development)
- o ACCN3010 (Managerial Accounting)
- o MGSC3010(Intro to Business Analytics)
- o Courses to complete their major(s), minor, and/or certificates
- o Two courses to complete the "Text and Historic" requirement
- o A course that fulfills the "Global Perspectives" requirement (may overlap with "Text and Historic" requirement)
- o A course that fulfills the "Race and Inclusion" requirement (may overlap with "Text and Historic" requirement)
- o A course that fulfills the "Aesthetic and Creative Arts" requirement(may overlap with "Global Perspectives" requirement)

How do majors and minors work?

Students can have a single major with no minor, a single major with one minor, or two majors. Each major requires six or seven courses and each minor requires three or four courses. Major and minor courses cannot overlap. A student opting to take a single major will be required to take at least four business elective courses. Students will need to see their advisors to find out what courses they specifically need for their major and minor.

When should students meet with their academic advisor?

ICADE students should meet with Ms. Maddie Rich (mrich@tulane.edu) ideally before the first week of class so that their schedule can be checked for duplicate/inappropriate courses. They can learn about on campus resources and their curriculum. From then on, they can meet once or twice a semester.
