III. APPLICATION

Nomination Procedure

- Partner Exchange Coordinator sends us Nomination via email (including name, gender, email, passport number or national ID number, study period at Comillas & studies level)
- After the nomination period, nominated incoming students will receive login access to complete the on-line application form.

Nominations Deadlines

Fall Semester (1st)

E.U. nomination deadline: June 1, 2024

Spring Semester (2nd)

E.U. Nomination deadline: Nov 1, 2024

Duration of Exchange

1 semester or 1 academic year. Students are expected to complete their entire exchange programme at Comillas including final exams. Neither exemptions nor special arrangements with teaching staff can be made to schedule exams or re-stis on other dates, times or places.

Application Procedure

PHASE I:

Online application due by June 30 (Nov. 30 for Spring semester students)

Copy of passport or National ID card.

Documents that should be uploaded with your application

Passport size photo.

- Copy of your medical insurance showing coverage for the time you are at Comillas. Comillas does not have its own medical insurance so, you should purchase it before arriving in Comillas. Your insurance policy should cover at least sickness, hospitalization, accidents, repatriation and civil liability for the entire period of stay.
- European Health Insurance Card is accepted for EU students.

IV. ACADEMIC CALENDAR

NOTE: Students should wait for the FINAL exam schedule to be available prior to make any travel arrangements for the end of the semester. If they must book or buy their flight tickets in advance, they can do it for the next day after the official date of the end of the semester.

The final exam schedule can take up to two months to be posted. We will not accept any demand on the exam dates by the students for any reason, (economic or any kind). In all cases, it is NOT possible nor allowed to re-arrange the regular exam dates at Comillas or make individual arrangments with professors. The professors are not in charge of the exam calendar so the students should not request anything to them about the exam. No exemptions!

Fall Semester (1st) Classes begin: October 2, 2024

Christmas Holidays begin: December 20, 2024

Spring Semester (2nd) Spring: Early February,

(the start date will be determinated)

Easter Holidays: April 12 - 21, 2024

NOTE 2: The transcripts of records with the final grades will be sent via email to the home institutions, at least two months after the end of the semester.



V. LEARNING EXPECTATIONS

Class Format Most courses are characterized by traditional teaching with lectures,

written course assignments and/or oral presentations.

Many of the courses require substantial preparatory reading.

Attendance Attendance is expected, but policies are based

on each instructor's discretion.

Participation Class participation is part of a student's final grade

in most courses.

Grading From 0 to 10 being 5 the passing grade.

Please, note that Transcripts are sent to home institutions at the end of March for students enrolled only in the Fall semesterand at the end

of August for annual or Spring semester students.

Course Choices The Master coordinator will contact the students a month before

the begining of each semester asking them the list of courses they are interested in. The exchange student could only select courses from the Master in Business Administration and in principle the classes will be in English, (the possibility of taking courses in Spanish must be discussed).

Full-time Workload ICADE Comillas uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

Normal workload for a full time Spanish student is 30 ECTS per

semester or 60 ECTS per academic year.

Examination Most are written examinations.

Language of Instruction English

FINAL TRANSCRIPTS: the exchange students do not need to request their final transcript. They could get an informative transcript in the Comillas Intranet once they have all their final grades. Nevertheless, the official transcript will be sent via email directly to their home universities. The official documents will be ready up to one month after the end of the semester.

SPECIAL NEEDS / ACCOMODATIONS: When the student's needs may require the adoption of significant accommodations or especial needs, the Comillas will facilitate and promote the integration of these students. However, it will be arbitrated for the purposes of the necessary means in accordance with the provisions of current regulations. All students who have a disability certificate or have an accredited special need may request curricular adaptations. Curricular adaptations are individual, and are issued depending on the type and degree of need in accordance with the current regulations of the Community of Madrid.

Spanish Language Classes

We offer classes adapted to all levels of the European Common

Framework.

Fall semester: from October to December, 2023 or February, 2024 (Before the Master classes begin. The students who are interested in taking Spanish Language Classes must be aware this course will start almost a month before the M.B.A. So the student will stay almost a month with just that course).

Spring semester: from February to May, 2024
