'Because none of the professors know how to use it so I had to explain it to them and hope that it works out, which was very stressful.'



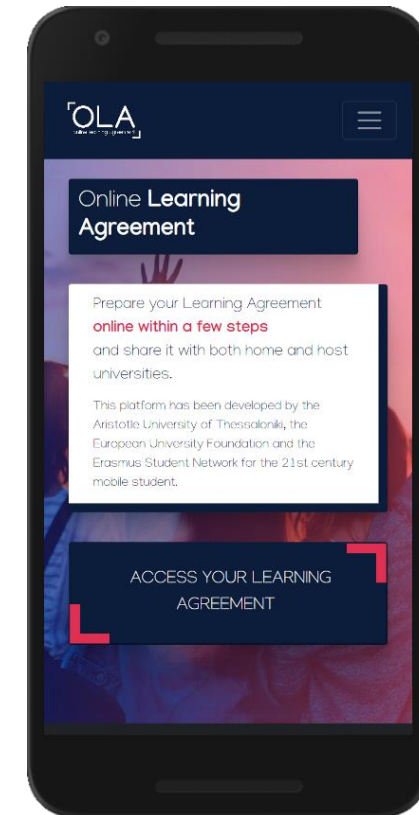
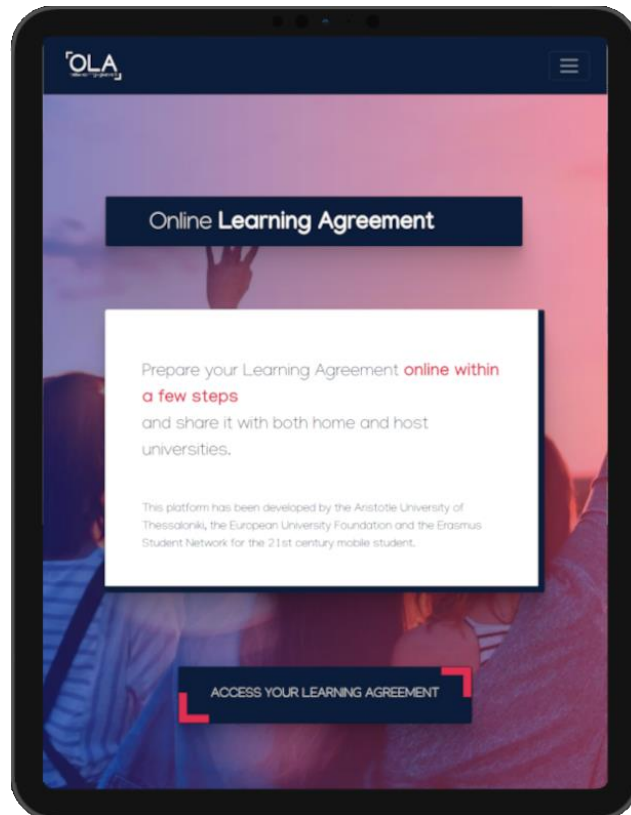
