HEALTHY LIVING AND CULTURAL DYNAMICS

Reims is a small city (less than 190 000 inhabitants), but it also offers all the opportunities of a big city in terms of culture, well-being and sport.

Performance venues, a multitude of theme bars, two internationally recognised theatres, an exhibition centre, a conference centre, several museums as well as festivals organised throughout the year... Cultural events and locations are on the increase in Reims.

Many parks and open spaces are available for outdoor activities, along with sports and recreational clubs and facilities. The campus also has its own gym and the student sports clubs are very active.

Lodging


Lodging in Reims is quite affordable : €400/450 per month.
